VC MARSHALS OUT MODALITIES TO COMBAT SUICIDE MENACE



The Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Charles O. Esimone, FAS has disclosed plans to combat the menace of suicide which is rampant in most Nigerian higher institutions.

The VC revealed this during a visit from the Nigerian Medical Student's Association led by the Dean of Medicine, Prof. Kenneth C. Ezech. The Professor of Biopharmaceutics and Pharmaceutical Microbiology laid his plans bare when the Student Doctors' Magazine crew sought to know how he would respond to the suicide rate which is fast

becoming an epidemic in Nigerian Universities.

Reacting to the question, Prof. Esimone, FAS said, "Suicidal tendencies, from study, don't have their root in the school environment. They come mostly from broken homes, extortions and of course, lack of communication between students and their parents," he said. The VC did not just apportion the blame only to students' homes but also admitted that external factors could also contribute. In this regard, Prof. Esimone adumbrated modalities such as: establishing psychological counseling units in all UNIZIK campuses; building more sporting arenas and activities to curb idleness; music shows, operas for both staff and students at the Amphitheatre by the Department of Theatre Arts and Films Studies, among others.

The Vice-Chancellor further stated that erecting model classrooms that are student-friendly and conducive as well as building a feedback system where students air and vent what they feel about self and lectures will help, too.

The UNESCO Avicenna Prize for Ethics in Science 2019 calls for nomination

The Prize aims to:

1. (a) Reward activities of individuals and groups in the field of ethics in science; and (b) Encourage ethical reflection, research and activities on issues raised by recent scientific and technological advances.

The Prize consists of a gold Avicenna medal, a certificate and the sum of **USD50,000**. Also, the prize-winner would be expected to pay a one-week academic visit to the Islamic Republic of Iran.

2. The theme of this year's Prize is "Ethics of

Environment" with a specific thematic focus on the ethics of climate change and environmental sustainability.
