UNIVERSITY PRO-CHANCELLOR PASSES ON

The Pro-Chancellor and Chairman of Governing Council of the University, Alhaji Azeez Oladotun Bello is dead.

In a press statement signed by the University Registrar, Barr. Philomena Okoye, Alhaji Bello died in the wee hours of Tuesday, October 15, 2019 in Atlanta after a brief illness.

The Registrar described the late Pro-Chancellor as a man of intergrity and an epitome of excellence.

Part of the statemen reads, "The Chancellor, Council,

Senate, Staff, Students and the entire University community join the family in mourning our departed Pro-Chancellor. The University flag would be flown on half mast for a period of 3 days".

The late Pro-chancellor was buried according to Islamic rites in Atlanta on Wednesday 16th October, 2019.

The 40th Day prayer would hold on Saturday, November 23rd, 2019. Other details in respect of the 40th day prayer will be announced by the family and communicated to the University Community and the general public in due course.

UNIZIK LAUNCHES EXECUTIVE PROGRAMME ON MIGRATION STUDIES



Identifying Migration as an increasingly important factor in the economic and socio-political policies of government, Nnamdi Azikiwe University recently established a Centre for Migration Studies (CMS) which is the first in the country, in a bid to responding to the local and global challenges and potentials thrown up by migration through the academic lens.

The Centre recently in Abuja formally presented her Master's Degree Programmes for Migration Studies to stakeholders of Nigerian Migration Management and Governance.

Declaring the presentation open, the Executive Secretary of the National Universities Commission (NUC), Professor Abubakar Rasheed who was represented by the immediate former Vice-Chancellor of UNIZIK, Professor Joseph Ahaneku, FAS described the issue of Migration as one that has continued to generate concern globally and locally.

Commending the University for taking the bold step in

developing framework for the CMS, Professor Rasheed urged stakeholders in the migration management to identify ways to partner with the University, maintaining that the core essence of institutions of learning such as UNIZIK is identifying solutions to problems bedeviling the society.

In his remark, the Vice-Chancellor of the University, Professor Charles Esimone, FAS averred that migration is a world-wide phenomom and could be triggered by social, economic and political factors or a combination of these. Prof. Esimone who equally had Professor Ahaneku as his Representative, noted that most countries of the world are caught in Migration matrix as home, transit or destination countries, throwing up many challenges particularly, the need to improve and protect the rights of vulnerable migrants. He disclosed that in the light of these Migration concerns, the University deemed it pertinent to establish CMS to respond to these concerns from the academic angle.

He commended the contributions of persons and institutions that are supporting the development of the centre.

Prof. Esimone solicited further collaboration and support from stakeholders through scholarships for candidates interested in undertaking Postgraduate Studies in Migration Studies in the centre, sponsorships for other projects and programs of the Centre as well as facilitating exchanges with foreign Universities and centres to make the programmes of the Centre internationally competitive.



Presenting the programmes to the stakeholders, the Director of the Centre, Professor Ike Odimegwu disclosed the aim of the Centre as providing knowledge-based foundation and framework for understanding management and governance of migration in Nigeria and the world at large. Professor Odimegwu listed the Master's programmes to include Master of Arts in Migration Studies (MA), Master of Science in Migration Studies (MSc) and Master of Migration Studies (MMS).

According to him, the MA and MSc are academic degrees for those who desire to proceed to PhD in Migration Studies whose duration is 18 months while the MMS is a professional degree for policy makers and implementers, civil society actors and other operators in the field of migration.

In his words, "The CMS-NAU Executive degrees are designed to serve the theoretical, practical and certification demands of academics, policy makers and implementers and actors in the field of Migrations".

"At CMS-NAU, we strategically carry out quality research, teach our students using technology tools and use all medium available to preach on regular migration.

"CMS-NAU was born in collaboration and has grown in collaboration. UNIZIK GOVERNING COUNCIL DISMISSES "DR." EKEMEZIE

The University Governing Council at its 8th Emergency meeting held on Thursday, 10th October, 2019 considered the report of the Joint Council/Senate Disciplinary Committee that investigated the following:

- i) Authenticity of the Postgraduate certificates allegedly issued to "Dr." Ekemezie by Nnamdi Azikiwe University, Awka
- ii) Duration of studies leading to the award of the PGD and Ph.D degrees
- iii) If "Dr." Ekemezie was a full time lecturer of Paul University while at the same time a staff of Nnamdi Azikiwe University, Awka
- iv) Plagiarism

Council, after exhaustively considering the report, found that:

- I) Mr. Ekemezie's M.Sc's result with Reg. No. 2004351001P with effective date of 24th

November, 2005 was not issued by Nnamdi Azikiwe University;

- ii) That "Dr." Ekemezie's Ph.D result with Reg. No. 2007547004P with effective date of 3rd August, 2009 was issued in error, arising from false information he supplied the Postgraduate School;
- iii) The case of plagiarism against him was established; and
- iv) While in employment of Nnamdi Azikiwe University, "Dr." Ekemezie had full-time employments in other institutions/organizations.

In the light of the above, the council decided as follows:

- i) That "Dr." Ekemezie be dismissed from the University with effect from 10th October, 2019
- ii) "Dr." Ekemezie is directed to hand over all University property in his possession to the Head, Department of Pure and Industrial Chemistry.
