#### RE: DRESSING PATTERNS THAT ARE CONSIDERED INDECENT FOR STAFF AND STUDENTS ON CAMPUS AND THEIR RECOMMENDED PUNISHMENTS

Senate at its 221<sup>st</sup> meeting held on September 20, 2023 deliberated extensively on the above subject, and thereafter, decided as follows:

S/N	OFFENCE	PENALTY
1.	Wearing of transparent dress and other clothes revealing male/female sexual organs, breasts and buttocks.	Community Service for one (1) month and undertaking to be of good behavior, failure to carryout the service leads to one (1) semester suspension.
2.	Mini bumshorts and skimpy skirts/dress above knee level to lecture and offices in the University.	Community Service for one (1) month and undertaking to be of good behavior, failure to carryout the service leads to one (1) semester suspension.
3.	Wearing of tattered, dirty jeans with holes or obscene messages.	Community Service for one (1) month and undertaking to be of good behavior, failure to carryout the service leads to one (1) semester suspension.
4.	Wearing of 'baggy' 'Saggy' mini bumshorts, 'ass level' and any other form of indecent trousers.	Community Service for one (1) month and undertaking to be of good behavior, failure to carryout the service leads to one (1) semester suspension.
5.	Wearing of tight fitting apparels such as shirts and tops with obscene, obnoxious or seductive inscription.	Community Service for one (1) month and undertaking to be of good behavior, failure to carryout the service leads to one (1) semester suspension.
6.	Wearing of shirts without buttons or improperly buttoned to expose breasts and chest.	Community Service for one (1) month and undertaking to be of good behavior, failure to carryout the service leads to one (1) semester suspension.
7.	Wearing of earrings by male students and wearing of nose, eyes and tongue rings by female students.	Community Service for one (1) month and undertaking to be of good behavior, failure to carryout the service leads to one (1) semester suspension.
8.	Plaiting weaving or bonding of hair by male students.	Community Service for one (1) month and undertaking to be of good behavior, failure to carryout the service leads to one (1) semester suspension.
9.	Wearing bathroom rubber slippers to lecture halls.	Warning and undertaking not to engage in the act again. Failure to abide by the warning leads to one (1) month suspension

10.	Wearing of lousy, unkempt, extremely bogus hair or coloured artificial hair and brightly tinted hair.	Community Service for one (1) month and undertaking to be of good behavior, failure to carryout the service leads to one (1) semester suspension.
11.	Artificial dreadlock by male students	Community Service for one (1) month and undertaking to be of good behavior, failure to carryout the service leads to one (1) semester suspension.
12.	Wearing of off shoulder/backless clothes	Community Service for one (1) month and undertaking to be of good behavior, failure to carryout the service leads to one (1) semester suspension.


Senate also decided that the Safety Department of the University should ensure that its staff are properly trained to ensure appropriate Implementation.

Furthermore, Senate directed Deans of Faculties and Heads of Departments to work in liaison with the Dress Code Committee to commence immediate sensitization of students on the decisions.

The effective date for the commencement of the sanctions will be January, 2024.
